Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section on the form for exhibitors to indicate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please circle yes or no so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$50.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club is accepting online entries through the AKC Online Entry System. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries: 150; Paper entries: 200. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.)

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place Indoors on a dirt surface. Ring sizes will be 90' x 100' and 85' x 100. Contacts will be rubberized. **All tunnels are 26" in diameter.**

MOVE UPS

Requests for move-ups for Friday, October 7, must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary by **Monday, October 3, at 6:00pm PDT**. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must be made in writing prior to one half hour after the last run of the day. A move-up form is included in this Premium.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space Crating in the Main Arena is limited. Event Committee Members have priority to crating in the main arena. Indoor crating is also available in the warm-up area (connected to the main arena via an indoor hallway). Please **limit the size of your crating set-up**. If possible, work out of your vehicle. Set ups may be left overnight, however, the Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club, Inc. and Ironwood Events Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food/Drinks: Hospitality, including lunch, will be available at the trial. More information will be included with the class schedule. The nearest facilities for food, groceries, etc. are located 12 miles (approximately 15 minutes) South on the Pyramid Hwy.

Raffle: TMDTC will hold two separate raffles. A Workers' reward raffle will be held Saturday and Sunday. Friday's workers will have their names placed into Saturday's Raffle. A separate raffle will be held for those wishing to purchase tickets.

RV Parking and Camping is available on-site. **Reservations are required.** The reservation form is included on this Premium. RV sites are available with electricity only (\$20 per night) or with both water and electricity (\$25 per night). Dry camping is also available for \$10 per night and tent camping(outdoors only) is \$10 per night. **There is no public RV dump station at Ironwood. Dump stations can be found at the following locations:** Spanish Springs Boat and RV Storage 100 Ingenuity Ave Sparks, NV 89441 775-644-3270. For those traveling I-80 West – Cabela's or KOA Boomtown at Exit 4. For those traveling US 395/I-580 South – Washoe Lake State Park on East Lake Blvd.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. **If you may obtain a MACH/PACH at this trial, please note it on your entry form.**

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The **Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club Inc.** and **Ironwood Events Center**, and its agents, employees, etc., will assume **No** responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The **Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club Inc.** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the **Truckee Meadows Dog Training Club Inc.**, **Ironwood Events Center** or any official thereof.

All dogs must be always on leash when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND LIABILITY FOR COVID-19

Please see the additional page with this information. Your signature on the entry form affirms that you have read and understand the waiver.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season will be fully refunded if withdrawn after closing. Written Notification must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public-address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

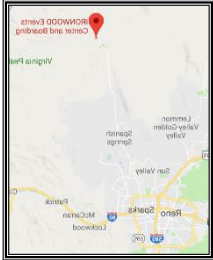

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

5600 Whiskey Springs Road Sparks, NV 89510

The facility is approximately 18 miles north of I-80 on Pyramid Way. It's an easy **20 minute** drive out the Pyramid Highway. You'll know you have arrived when you drive past the BLM wild horse holding pens on the east (right) side of the road. . You really can't miss the facility; it is the large, red-roofed building and is easily seen from the highway on the east side of the road. **DO NOT TURN ON IRONWOOD ROAD!** Go past Ironwood Road approximately ½ mile and turn right (east) onto Whiskey Springs Road. Parking is on the east side of the largest building.



From I-80 & Pyramid Way in Sparks: Go north on Pyramid Way 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Road, then turn right.

From Sacramento: Take I-80 East to the Pyramid Way off-ramp (at the Nugget). Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go north on Pyramid Way 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Road, then turn right.

From Carson City/Minden/Gardnerville via US 395: Take US 395/I-580 North to I-80 East. Take I-80 East to the Pyramid Way off-ramp (at the Nugget). Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go north on Pyramid Way 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Road, then turn right.

PARKING/UNLOADING Parking is available on the East side of the building, just past the outdoor arenas. The building entrance is located on the east side of the building, across the roadway from the outdoor arena.

There is a driveway for unloading adjacent to the building. Please consider others and keep this area clear. Unloading/loading is limited to 15 minutes.

IRONWOOD EVENT CENTER RULES PLEASE REVIEW CAREFULLY

We are extremely fortunate to use this wonderful facility for our agility trials. In order to be able to keep on using it, we have agreed that our exhibitors will cooperate with the following rules:

- ***Dogs are to be always leashed unless in the ring or in a designated off-leash area.***
- ***Exhibitors are NOT to use the dirt planters around the building to potty their dogs. (Please stay out of the dirt planters altogether.) Dogs are to be walked on-leash to the bare dirt, sagebrush areas to potty. If at all possible, do not allow your dogs to potty on any grass.***
- ***Horses have the right of way! Please keep dogs away from horses in the outdoor stalls and arenas.***
- ***All exhibitors must leave the facility Sunday after the trial. No overnight camping Sunday evening.***
- ***If BBQ's are used, they must be gas BBQ's – no charcoal please.***
- ***No one is to be in any of the electrical or mechanical rooms or panels.***
- ***Heaters, fans and lights are set by the facility managers. The only person to request a change will be Erna Slingland, trial chair***
- ***Campers must have a permit on their RV, trailer or tent to use any of the facilities. Permits may be picked up from Melissa Hardy, trial secretary, or Erna Slingland after 2 pm Thursday, October 6, and before 3pm each day.***
- ***Dogs are allowed in the arena area of the building, as well the crating areas. They are not allowed in the downstairs lounge area, the Short Round Lounge upstairs, any restrooms or showers or the stable area.***

- Match tickets can be picked up and/or additional runs can be purchased from Terry Popish prior to the match (exact cash amount or checks made out to TMDTC). No tickets will be sold once the match has begun.
- Classes offered: Standard and Jumpers. One course will be set in each ring. You may run the numbered course or your own pattern. Tickets may be used in any ring.
- No scoring or prizes will be offered. Match will begin after the regular trial is finished on Friday.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs must be a minimum of 1 year in age. Any AKC eligible dog may enter. Dogs do not need to be entered in the regular trials. Dogs may be entered multiple times in the same class with a maximum of 4 runs per dog.
- You may run at any jump height.
- Each run will be a maximum of 60 seconds. Maximum course time will be strictly enforced.
- Toys and clickers are allowed in the ring. Food is not allowed in the ring.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY
COVID 19
