Entry Method and Payment Options:

- Completed and Signed Entry Form accompanied by a Check or Money Order made out to TMDTC and mailed to the Trial Secretary.
- Completed and Signed entry form with payment may be dropped off at the clubhouse for the trial secretary.
- Enter online at Eagerdog.com. https://www.eagerdog.com and complete a city search for Reno to find the event to enter the rally trials.

ENTRIES open Wednesday, October 22, 2015 at 6 AM (PST). Due to limited entries, they must be submitted via one of the following methods:

- Physically-mailed to the secretary's address
- Enter online at https://www.eagerdog.com, search for city "Reno" to find the event
- Drop the entries in the envelope at the clubhouse

No entry will be accepted before the opening date and time. If your entry arrives before the opening date/time you will be notified, and the entry will be shredded. You will be allowed to send another entry. **No entries will be accepted by phone or fax**. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Hand delivered entries will be accepted in the designated location at the TMDTC Clubhouse.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: 6:00 PM (PST) Wednesday, November 19, 2025 OR when the maximum entry has been reached, after which no entries may be accepted, canceled or changed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

TELEPHONE, FAXED, UNSIGNED or INCOMPLETE ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms & photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Incomplete includes failure to insert jump height in a class requiring it.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.

How To Use The Entry Blank: Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the same for each day. Carefully check the box for each show in which you wish to enter your dog. A separate form should be used if the same dog is entered in different classes on different days. The boxes indicating the shows you wish to enter must be checked. Please TYPE or PRINT all information on entry forms.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, venue contract cancellation or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

Refunds for bitches in season will be given less \$5.00 for administrative fees. Written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before judging starts.

Full refund for bitches in season if trial secretary is notified before the Monday preceding the event.

Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16a of the Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to start of that day's judging. (before 8AM)

Rally Event Grounds rules

- 1. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
- 2. You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle idling in the parking area.
- Keep dogs on leash while not working. Potty your dog designated potty area. Do not potty dogs on the venue landscaping.
- 4. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

name on the back of your armband and put it in the drawing for that prize. Drawing is pulled at the end of the day after the last classes are judged.


A very special item will be raffled on Sunday, December 14, 2025 at 2 PM during the TMDTC Winter Rally trials!

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

- No set up for exhibitors before 6 AM on Friday, December 12, 2025.
- Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the ring or when in a designated warm-up area.
- There shall be NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the
 behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/
 or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in
 unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial
 Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of
 any fees paid will be made.
- Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside when it is their turn to be judged.
- Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged.
- In case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
- No Award will be mailed or delivered.
- Day crate space is limited please be considerate and take a minimum footprint.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. (Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
- 3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
