#### **Entry Method and Payment Options:**

**Completed and signed entry form accompanied by a check or money order payable to TMDTC and mailed to the trial secretary.**

**Completed and Signed entry form accompanied by a check or money order payable to TMDTC and put in the "Obedience Entries" envelope at the clubhouse for the trial secretary.**

**Online entry at <https://www.eagerdog.com>. (Complete a city search for "Reno" to find the event to enter the obedience trials.)**

**ENTRIES open May 13, 2026 at 8 am (PST).** No entry will be accepted before the opening date and time. If your entry arrives before the opening date/time you will be notified and the entry will be rejected. You will be allowed to send another entry. No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's mailing address. Hand delivered entries will be accepted in the designated location at the TMDTC Clubhouse.

**CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: 12:00 PM, Wednesday, June 24, 2026** OR when the limits have been reached, after which no entries may be accepted, canceled or changed.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

TELEPHONE, FAXED, UNSIGNED or INCOMPLETE ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms & photocopies of entry forms without the **signed** Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. **Entries that fail to include the jump height in a class requiring it are incomplete. Entries that fail to designate A or B in a class requiring it are incomplete.**

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Acknowledgment of receipt of entries will be made soon after the closing date.

Should such acknowledgment not be received by an exhibitor seven days prior to the trial, please notify the Trial Secretary by phone (775 544-1545) or e-mail TMDTC.Trials@gmail.com. The club assumes no responsibility for a incomplete or wrong entries.

How to Use the Entry Blank: Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the same for each day. Carefully check the box for each show in which you wish to enter your dog. A separate form should be used if the same dog is entered in different classes on different days. The boxes indicating the shows you wish to enter must be checked. Please TYPE or PRINT all information on entry forms.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, venue contract cancellation or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Refunds for bitches in season will be given less \$10.00 for administrative fees. Written notice must be given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before judging starts. Full refund for bitches in season will be given if the trial secretary is notified before the Monday preceding the event.

Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16a of the AKC Obedience Regulations. Please notify the trial secretary in writing as soon as possible, **but notice must be given at least 30 minutes prior to the 8:00 a.m. start of that day's judging.**



## Raffle

TMDTC will be offering a raffles at our trials. Our Raffle Committee works hard to create fun baskets in addition to select special items.

*Each day, there is also a drawing for a Consolation Basket.* If you NQ, put your name on the back of your armband and put it in the drawing for that day's prize. The drawing is made at the end of the day after the last classes are judged.



## ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

- No set up for exhibitors before 2PM on Thursday July 9, 2026. Set up will be from 2 PM to 4 PM.
- Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the ring or when in a designated warm-up area.
- NO FLEXI LEADS. Dogs may be on a 6' or shorter leash outside the ring or in the potty area.
- There shall be NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show premises or grounds.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Consult the Judging Program for time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside when it is their turn to be judged.
- Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged.
- In case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
- No award will be mailed or delivered.
- Day crating space is limited – please be considerate and take up a minimum footprint to accommodate your dogs and belongings. A 4x4 x-pen to accommodate two St. Bernards is fine; a 4x4 x-pen to accommodate one chihuahua is not.

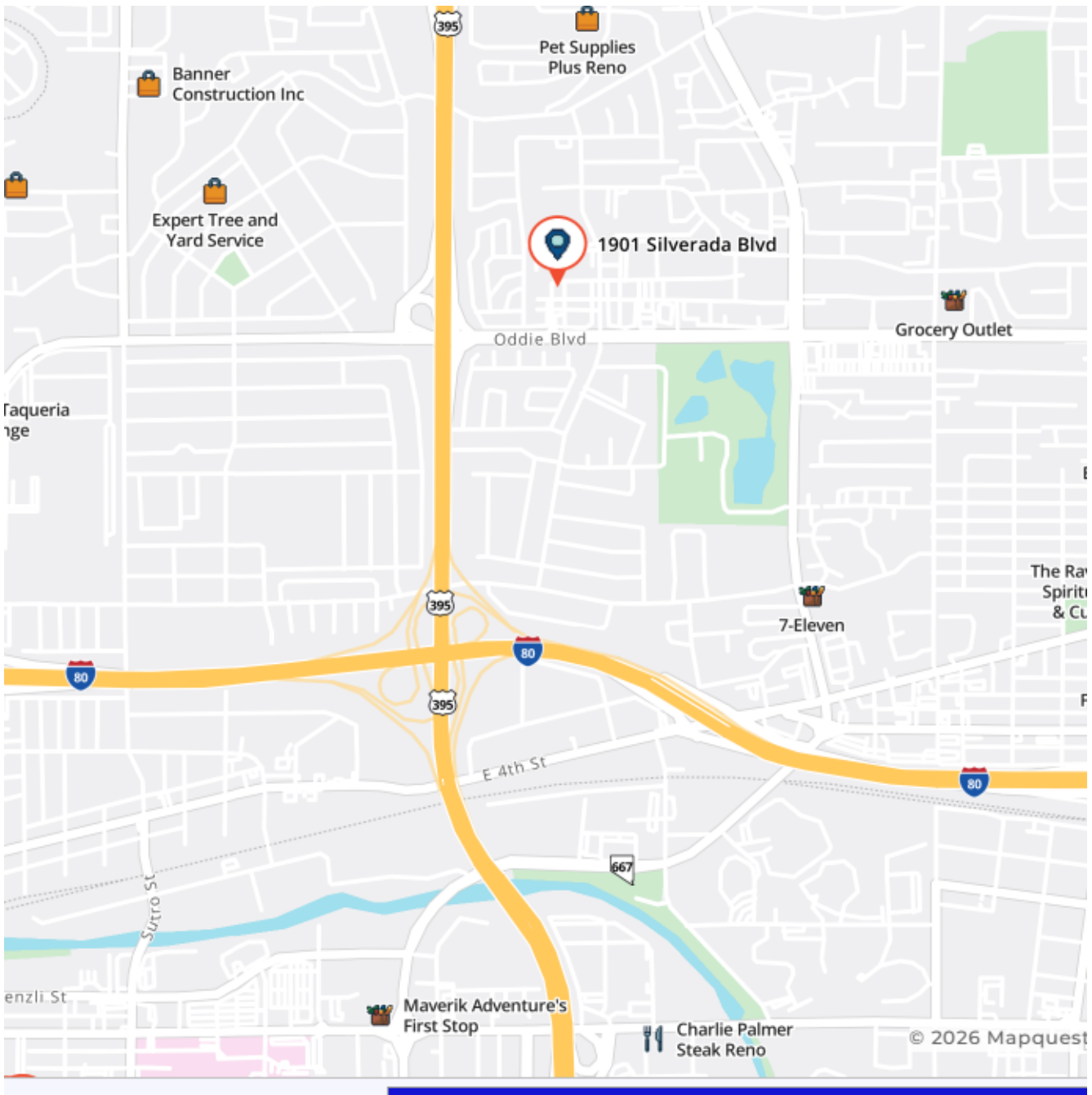
